Dear Frontier Local Parents:

Due to recent circumstances, the district is faced with a shortage of bus drivers and substitute bus drivers. Because of this shortage we are needing to adjust some of our bus drivers routes and the pickup and drop off times for our students. These adjustments are only temporary, we expect them to begin Monday, Jan. 22 through the end of February. These adjustments will only mean a 5 or 10 minute difference in pickup or drop off times. We will need your child to be ready at the normal pickup time but may be picked up 5 to 10 minutes later than normal and may be dropped off 5 to 10 minutes after their normal drop off time. The routes that are being affected are Rick Taylor's, Vicki Joy's, Bill Greenwood's and Tommy Smith's.

We realize we are transporting the most precious commodities as we transport your children to and from school. Their safety is our top priority as we are constantly working to make their educational experience the best we can provide them. Working together we will have the best outcome for the district as a whole.
